



Native Plant of the Year:
Redosier Dogwood
Cornus sericea



Unique Characteristics

A large, flowering shrub, the redosier dogwood's red branches have long been used to add winter interest to the landscape. Clusters of pea-sized white berries are an important source of food for resident and migrating birds in fall.

Plant type: **deciduous shrub**

Native range: **North America**

Sun: **full sun to part shade**

Water: **medium to wet**

Soil: **medium to wet**

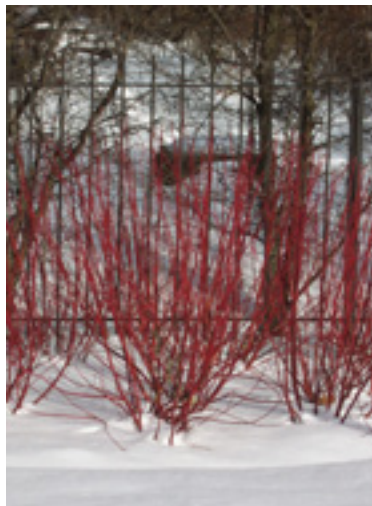
pH: **6.8 to 7.2**

Height: **6 to 12 feet**

Spread: **8 to 12 feet**

Wildlife: **attracts birds**

Hardiness zone: **3 to 8**
